ARGENTINA		CUVELIER LOS ANDES, TUNUYAN - MENDOZA				
<p>The vineyard was planted in 1999 with a density of 5500 plants per hectare. This is a similar density to those favored in Bordeaux but is rare in Argentina. Today the vineyard stretches over 55 hectares (136 acres) with 10 hectares still to plant. The main grape is Malbec. They have also planted Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Petit Verdot. This enables them to create their own blended wines and also contribute to those of Clos de los Siete. Basking in the warm, dry climate of Mendoza, cooled by the refreshing high air of the Andes, their vines are ideally situated to express the character of their various grape varieties in this stony, alluvial gravel soil.</p>

FRANCE		CHAMPAGNE DRAPPIER, CHAMPAGNE				SUSTAINABLE
Currently run by the 7th and 8th generations of the Drappier family, this grower was established in 1808. Its main claim to fame is that it was the 'house' champagne of French war hero General Charles de Gaulle, who loved it so much when he retired from public life, he came to live in a village a stone's throw from the Maison Drappier estate. Now that's what you call customer devotion! After the Second World War, Michel's father launched the House's classic NV style, Carte D'Or with its distinctive yellow label. The yellow colour is said to represent quince jelly, which the maker claims is reminiscent of the aromatics in his champagne.

FRANCE		CHAMPAGNE EGLY-OURIET, CHAMPAGNE				BIODYNAMIC
With some of the choicest sites and oldest Pinot Noir vines of any producer in the Montagne de Reims, Francis Egly gives you classic fruit qualities that you typically only find in great Burgundy. There are yellow fruits evident in the Pinot Noir, suggestions of peaches and apricots, and even blood orange notes. These are noble and complex qualities found in great red wine. More time on lees gives the wines added complexity ; added depth; and contributes to the intensity and vinousness of the entire lineup . Perhaps the most remarkable wine of Egly-Ouriet is the "basic" Brut NV that is often better than elite level crus. It is aged a minimum of 48 months on the lees giving it exceptional density, complexity and serious aging potential. It is 100% Grand Cru.

FRANCE		CHATEAU DE CORCELLES, BEAUJOLAIS			
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The legendary Château de Corcelles is located in the heart of Beaujolais and has been designated a National Heritage since 1927. Château de Corcelles has 92 hectares of vines spread over several terroirs enabling Gamay to express a range of styles. The Château produces Beaujolais, Beaujolais-Villages and Brouilly in its signature bottle. The combination of altitude (400 meters), exposure (south and south-east), soil (granite) and new trellising provide the best conditions for grape health and ripening. The vineyard has a high proportion of old vines with an average age of 40 years.

FRANCE		CHATEAU DES TOURS, BEAUJOLAIS			
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Between Mâcon and Lyon, in the heart of the Beaujolais vineyards and at the foot of Mount Brouilly we find this beautifully renovated, magnificent building, located in an exceptional setting in the middle of the vines. This is the Château des Tours with its superb Gamay vineyards, producer of Brouilly wine, one of the most seductive of the Beaujolais Crus. In the very centre of the Brouilly Appellation, the Château des Tours has 70 hectares of vines in the communes of Saint-Etienne-la-Varenne, Odenas and Saint-Lager. It is thus blessed with an exceptional terroir giving great wines. This extra touch of soul confers unique style to our wines which are well known to specialists.

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FRANCE		JEAN-PAUL & BENOIT DROIN, CHABLIS				ORGANIC	
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The Droin family is amongst the oldest in Chablis, its members having been wine growers for nearly five centuries. Since the year of 1620, fourteen generations of vigneron have transmitted their "savoir-faire" down from father to son. The domaine's extensive premier and grand cru holdings span the entire range of the Chablis stylistic repertory. From mineral La Montée de Tonnerre, Vaudésir and Les Clos to fruitier and softer-textured Vaillons, La Fourchaume and Valmur, with Montmains somewhere in between adding citrus and floral notes, site specific nuances of flavour (and Chablis is all about nuances) are accurately translated into bottle.

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FRANCE		CHATEAU LA NERTHE, CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RHONE VALLEY				ORGANIC	
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This domaine could easily be 800 years old, even if the first document in which it is mentioned dates from 1560. At that time, the domaine was called Grange de Beauvenir and belonged to the aristocratic family Tulle de Villefranche originating in the Piedmont region of Italy. Back then, the domaine's wines were highly renowned and seem to have titillated the palates of many rich and noble ladies and gentlemen, including the court of King Louis XVI. In 1991, the Château la Nerthe acquired 22 hectares of vineyards from Terre Ferme, whereby its total planting area grew to 90 hectares. Château la Nerthe thus became one of the biggest wine producers in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The terroir of the vineyards has a broad spectrum of various kinds of soil.

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At only 8 hectares in size, this miniscule, ultra-traditional estate produces tiny quantities of just one wine: no luxury cuvée, no specialty blend, just a stunningly pure and complex Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Owner Claude Courtil is the godson of none other than Henri Bonneau, one of the most legendary and revered producers in the region, and he learned everything he knows about winemaking from his godfather. Henri and Claude share a deeply held commitment to natural winemaking: manual vineyard work, traditional aging in large foudres, and bottling without intrusive fining and filtration. Vines are over 60 years old!

BRUNO GIACOSA & AZIENDA FALLETTO, PIEMONTE

Bruno Giacosa is renowned as one of the greatest winemakers in all of the Langhe. Bruno Giacosa's cellars are in Nieve and he has just over 17 hectares of vines in Barbaresco and Barolo. In 1982, he bought the remarkable FALLETTO vineyard in Serralunga. Giacosa firmly believes in the value of single-vineyard bottlings. The wines of Bruno Giacosa are classic 'vini da meditazione'; marvellously perfumed on the nose and meaty and full-bodied on the palate. They have a suppleness and elegance that few wines in the region can match. They are built to last. Bruno Giacosa sadly died in early 2018. His daughters, Bruna and Marina remain at the helm, united by their father's obsessive antipathy towards mediocrity.

Domodimonti's new state-of-the-art winery is designed to generate the least amount of visual and ecological disturbances on the local environment, while producing some of Le Marche's most desired wines. The winery was built into a valley so as to not disturb the naturally precious scenic beauty of the surrounding area. Additionally, solar panels, hidden from view, and the reuse of rain water allow Domodimonti to be partially dependent on renewable energy and resources. It is a marriage between ecological sustainability, and the production of natural products, which defines the cornerstone of Domodimonti's philosophy.

The Fattoria I Veroni is located in the municipality of Pontassieve about 10 km from Florence, in the Chianti Rufina. The winery was founded in 1895, but the first buildings, built as watch towers, date back to the twelfth century. Today the company is owned by the Mariani family, which owns about 50 hectares of land, of which 30 are used for olive grove and 20 vineyards totally cultivated according to the dictates of organic farming. Both of their Chianti Rufina, are absolutely remarkable wines, soft and velvety, which preserve the aromas and flavors of Tuscany.

Josetta Saffirio winery has 200 years of tradition in cultivating the vineyards. The wine production started in 1975 when Josetta Saffirio took over the winery from her father. In 1985 Josetta and her husband Roberto presented their first Barolo with the current label. All labels with gnomes were designed by Josetta. In 2006 the new sustainable cellar was built, fully integrated with the surroundings and isolated with the natural cork. Focus on new sustainable solutions, technologies, like photovoltaic system; reduction of CO2 and oil production, led the winery to the sustainable certification in 2015. The winery is currently receiving their organic certification.
