ARGENTINA		CUVELIER LOS ANDES, TUNUYAN - MENDOZA					
<p>The vineyard was planted in 1999 with a density of 5500 plants per hectare. This is a similar density to those favored in Bordeaux but is rare in Argentina. Today the vineyard stretches over 55 hectares (136 acres) with 10 hectares still to plant. The main grape is Malbec. They have also planted Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Petit Verdot. This enables them to create their own blended wines and also contribute to those of Clos de los Siete. Basking in the warm, dry climate of Mendoza, cooled by the refreshing high air of the Andes, their vines are ideally situated to express the character of their various grape varieties in this stony, alluvial gravel soil.</p>

FRANCE		CHAMPAGNE DRAPPIER, CHAMPAGNE						
<p>Champagne Drappier is THE high-quality negociant in the Aube. Drappier was founded in 1808 in Urville, in the center of the Aube department. It was Drappier that brought Pinot Noir to the Aube in the 1930s, a move that was mocked at the time--now it is by far the most planted grape in the region. A little more than half of the production comes from their 130+ acres of estate vineyard. The other part comes from long-term contracts. The wines go through malolactic, with very little sulfur--they claim to have the lowest sulfur counts of any major negociant. They pride themselves on low-temperature fermentation.</p>

<p>Pierre and Sophie Larmandier farm 40 hectares morsellated into an even larger number of parcels in Vertus and villages on either side. Their wines are exceptional in every way. Larmandier practices a non-interventionist philosophy in the vineyards with an emphasis on low yields. A similar approach is taken in the cellar, where the wines are fermented with natural yeasts and bottled with low or no dosage in order to exalt the qualities of the sites the estate works with. The Larmandier-Bernier Champagnes are some of the purest and most utterly engaging wines being made in the region today.</p>

FRANCE		JEAN-PAUL & BENOIT DROIN, CHABLIS - BURGUNDY					ORGANIC	
<p>The Droin family is amongst the oldest in Chablis, its members having been wine growers for nearly five centuries. Since the year of 1620, fourteen generations of vigneronns have transmitted their "savoir-faire" down from father to son. The domaine's extensive premier and grand cru holdings span the entire range of the Chablis stylistic repertory. From mineral La Montée de Tonnerre, Vaudésir and Les Clos to fruitier and softer-textured Vaillons, La Fourchaume and Valmur, with Montmains somewhere in between adding citrus and floral notes, site specific nuances of flavour (and Chablis is all about nuances) are accurately translated into bottle.</p>

FRANCE		CHATEAU LA NERTHE, CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RHONE VALLEY				ORGANIC	
This domaine could easily be 800 years old, even if the first document in which it is mentioned dates from 1560. At that time, the domaine was called Grange de Beauvenir and belonged to the aristocratic family Tulle de Villefranche originating in the Piedmont region of Italy. Back then, the domaine's wines were highly renowned and seem to have titillated the palates of many rich and noble ladies and gentlemen, including the court of King Louis XVI. In 1991, the Château la Nerthe acquired 22 hectares of vineyards from Terre Ferme, whereby its total planting area grew to 90 hectares. Château la Nerthe thus became one of the biggest wine producers in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The terroir of the vineyards has a broad spectrum of various kinds of soil.

Henri and Claude share a deeply held commitment to natural winemaking: manual vineyard work, traditional aging in large foudres, and bottling without intrusive fining and filtration.

ITALY		ATTILIO GHISOLFI, PIEMONTE						
Lying along the road that winds its way up from Castiglione Falletto to Monforte, the Attilio Ghisolfi winery is surrounded by the vineyards of Bussia, one of the finest crus in the Barolo wine-growing area. The company has been run by Gianmarco since 1988, when he began bottling the wines that had been produced on the farm for three generations and had always been sold previously in bulk. The traditional local varieties (Nebbiolo, Barbera, Freisa) are grown on around 7 hectares (17 acres) of vineyards, alongside another which is quite unusual for this area: Pinot Noir. The most prestigious label is Barolo Bricco Visette, though since the 2000 vintage it has been joined – in the very best years only – by the winery's real showpiece, Barolo Riserva Fantini.

ITALY		BRUNO GIACOSA & AZIENDA FALLETTO, PIEMONTE						
Bruno Giacosa is renowned as one of the greatest winemakers in all of the Langhe. Bruno Giacosa's cellars are in Nieve and he has just over 17 hectares of vines in Barbaresco and Barolo. In 1982, he bought the remarkable FALLETTO vineyard in Serralunga. Giacosa firmly believes in the value of single-vineyard bottlings. The wines of Bruno Giacosa are classic 'vini da meditazione'; marvellously perfumed on the nose and meaty and full-bodied on the palate. They have a suppleness and elegance that few wines in the region can match. They are built to last. Bruno Giacosa sadly died in early 2018. His daughters, Bruna and Marina remain at the helm, united by their father's obsessive antipathy towards mediocrity.

The history of Hedges Family Estate begins in June of 1976, with the marriage of Tom Hedges and Anne-Marie Liégeois in a 12th century church in Champagne, France. The convergence of separate cultural upbringings provides a strong backdrop for creating a modern day, but traditionally inspired wine estate. Ten years after their wedding, an opportunity to become entrepreneurs presented itself; Tom and Anne-Marie created an export company called American Wine Trade, Inc., based out of Kirkland, Washington State; they began selling wine to foreign importers. As the company grew, it began to source Washington wines for a larger clientele leading to the establishment of a negociant-inspired wine called Hedges Cellars. This 1987 blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot was sold to the Swedish Wine and Spirit Monopoly, Vin & Sprit Centralen, the company's first major client.
