"A spicy Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre blend with a lightly meaty, smoky undercurrent. Very southern Rhône - aromatic, elegant and yet very pure. Flavours on the palate are beautifull integrated with feathery tannins and an abundance of sweet red fruit. Pure, authentic and well-priced."

Grapes - 62% Grenache, 26% Shiraz, 12% Mourvèdre

Vineyards - Grapes comes from the sub-regions of Marananga, Gomersal, Ebenezer. A combination of terroirs contribute to the complexity of this wine. Old vines sites - some more than 100 years old.

Winemaking - Hand-picked grapes. Gentle basket-pressing, and 24 months maturation in well-seasoned French oak.

Tasting Notes - A lifted aromatic of red fruits from Grenache balanced with savoury aromas from Mourvèdre. Cherry, pomegranate, wet earth, are also evident. The palate is medium bodied with soft tannins and long acidity. A wine to match with lamb and game meats.
