

## TORBRECK WOODCUTTER'S SHIRAZ

## 92 Points, Wine Enthusiast, Editor's Choice (2019)

This wine offers oodles of plush, plump plum and cherry accented by flowers, peppery spice, soy and iron. The palate delivers what the nose suggests. It's broad shouldered but neatly cupped by fine, chalky tannins. There's a lucidity here thanks to minimal oak. Tangy fruit and a saline note carry the finish. It's a charming example of modern Barossa Shiraz.

## 91 Points, James Suckling (2019)

"Plenty of rich dark berries and some currant-like notes, too. There's a glossy feel with some fragrant elements (a little co-fermented roussanne and viognier). Attractive dark-plum and berry palate. Really vinous with a fresh finish.

Grape - 100% Shiraz

**Vineyards** - Fruit is hand-harvested and hand-tended from low-yielding vines from the sub-regions of Marananga, Greenock, Seppeltsfield, Gomersal, Moppa, Lyndoch, Eden Valley, Ebenezer.

**Winemaking** - Open fermented and gently basket-pressed before aging on fine lees for 12 months in large format seasoned barrels and foudres.

**Tasting Notes** - Full of freshness and bright youthful fruits, the 2019 vintage brings an opulence and class to the wines. Aromatic plum and raspberries with freshness and balance, the wine has a round central core of red fruit that gives way to a complex mid-palate full of cassis, dark cherry, spice and vanilla. While offering immense pleasure in its youth, the 2019 Woodcutter's - Shiraz will certainly develop into an impressive wine with a few more years in the cellar.
