"Foaming, vibrant and loaded with finesse, this radiant sparkler opens with delicate but enticing scents of fragrant spring blossom and white stone fruit. The dry elegant palate delivers Granny Smith apple, Bartlett pear and white almond alongside bright acidity and tiny, continuous bubbles. This is a gorgeous offering, and one that nicely shows the incredible potential of the Valdobbiadene hills."

Vineyards: Valdobbiadene is located in the heart of the Prosecco DOCG production zone at the foot of the Prealps, a mountain range in the southeastern part of the Alps. This region in the north-eastern part of Italy is most famous for the prized Prosecco vine and wine production because it has the greater concentration of high hillside vineyards. Vines are grown only on the sunniest parts of the hills, at altitudes varying between 50 and 500 meters above sea level. Nino Franco Brut Prosecco Superiore DOCG is made exclusively from the best vineyards planted on the high and medium hillside vineyards.

Winemaking: Pressing, de-stemming, cooling of must and fermentation in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature. Second fermentation in "cuvee close" Charmat Method.

Tasting Notes: Pale straw-coloured, and bright. Very fine bubbles, persistent, crisp, flowery and fruity. Refreshing and balanced. Apple and pear flavours that echo on the aftertaste.
